

St. Elizabeth Medical Center South Lab is Moving Temporarily

The South Lab is MOVING! Beginning April 5th, the ground floor lab (blood bank, hematology, chemistry, serology, send-out testing, and central processing) will temporarily relocate to other areas on the ground floor. Though we aren't decreasing the services offered, please understand that there will be an adjustment period with the move and re-organization of the departments.

Construction is expected to last 12 weeks. Here are some tips for the construction period:

Specimen drop-off for outpatient specimens.

Enter the hospital by the same door. Continue straight down the hall to the door on your LEFT, located between the Pharmacy and the Cafeteria. There will be a sign on the door.

- Please use either the front office or phlebotomy door.
 - Doors normally used to enter the lab (hall by cafeteria and back door by Cancer Care) are for construction use only.
- All phone calls will be answered by the Laboratory Call Center. Numbers typically used to call directly into a department will not be connected.

The laboratory staff will strive to continue to provide the timely, quality service for our patients. It is our hope that this temporary situation will make way for exceptional service in the near future.
