Pap Test: (Cervical Cancer Test – Same Day Results)_____
For women ages 21 to 65

- o It is required that your last Pap test was 3 or more years ago
- o You should not have had problems with past Pap tests or cervical cancer
- o You should not have current female health problems

Mammogram: (Breast Cancer Test – Results in About 7 Days)
For women ages 40 to 74

- o It is required that your last mammogram was 1 year or more ago
- o Your last mammogram must have been normal (no problems)
- o You should not have current breast problems or have had breast cancer Women ages 35 to 39 may get one baseline mammogram

- o Talk with our financial counselors
- o Learn about health insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare
- o Connect with the Health Department for free programs and_____ follow-up care
- o HPV vaccines (helps prevent cervical cancer)
- o Learn about preventing breast and cervical cancer - translated_____ and interpreted

- o Community resources and health education
- o Blood pressure checks
- o Learn about genetic testing – find out how it can help you and your family understand cancer risks
- o Take-away snack packages
- o Bring your family and friends to the Health Fair– children are welcome
