Quick recovery for Ky. man after life-saving scan showed spot on his lung

John Griess, a 66-year-old Bellevue, Ky. resident, had no noticeable symptoms before he was diagnosed with lung cancer early in 2016.

Dr. Royce Calhoun, a thoracic surgeon with St. Elizabeth Edgewood, gave Griess his options.

"He said you can wait and watch for six months for another biopsy or we can take it out now. In six months it could be bigger, so I wanted him to cut that out," Griess said. "They pulled it out and, sure enough, it was malignant, so we made the right choice."

Griess' tumor was removed by Calhoun in April 2016. After four days in the hospital, Griess was back home. A few weeks later, the U.S. Navy veteran was enjoying his favorite pastimes: golfing, singing in his classic rock and roll band, Cosmo's Factory, and babysitting his grandchildren with his wife.

Griess – who has lived in Kentucky most of his life – was a smoker from his teenage years until age 51, when he had a heart attack and quadruple bypass surgery. He hasn't smoked since his heart attack 15 years ago.

Eighty-five percent of lung cancer cases are caused by smoking. Calhoun suggests CT screening for lung cancer for anyone who is/was a heavy smoker (a pack per day for 30 years, 2 packs per day for 15 years or the equivalent), is age 55 years or older, a current or former smoker who quit smoking within the last 15 years.
