#### Description

Students who successfully complete the online course and skills session will receive a Heartsaver® CPR AED Course Completion card, valid for two years.

- **Traditional Classroom** This certification course is Instructor Led with a practice-while-watching AHA video format that includes focused skills learning and assessments throughout the program.

## Blended Learning Heartsaver CPR AED Certification Course

The Basic Heartsaver® CPR AED course is a modular program that teaches lay rescuers how to recognize and treat life-threatening emergencies.
