Our STARS services for children and teens range from PreK-18 years. Our licensed counselors, volunteers and specialists are highly trained to address the needs of grieving children and teens. In addition to individualized counseling, we also offer several grief events for children, teens and families throughout the year.

Our services are designed based on the STARS model, created by the St. Elizabeth Hospice Program. STARS is a Safe place in which kids can Talk about their grief, feel Accepted for what is thought and felt, feel Respected for what they need to do with their grief, and feel Supported as they meet together.
