Ellipta® Inhaler

Medications currently available in Ellipta®: BREO™, Arnuity™, Incruse™, Anoro™

- Slide the inhaler cover down until you hear a click. The inhaler is now ready to use.
 Do not shake!
- 2. Turn your head away from the inhaler, and blow out completely.

 Do not breathe into the inhaler!
- 3. Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- 4. Take one long, steady, deep breath in through your mouth.
 Do not block air vent with fingers.
- 5. Hold your breath for 10 seconds, or as long as possible.
- 6. Remove the inhaler from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- 7. Slide cover back into closed position.
- 8. Rinse your mouth. Do not swallow!



Medication currently available in HandiHaler®: Spiriva®

- 1. Pull the lid up away from the base of Handihaler® so the mouthpiece is showing.
- 2. Open the mouthpiece by pulling up and away from the base until the capsule chamber is seen.
- 3. Separate only one of the blisters from the foil pack and open it carefully to reveal the capsule.
- 4. Insert the capsule into the chamber.
- 5. Close the mouthpiece firmly back against the base until you hear a click.
- 6. Hold the device pointing up.
- 7. Press the green button one time. **Do not shake!**
- 8. Turn your head away from the inhaler and breathe out completely. *Do not breathe into the inhaler!*
- 9. Close your lips around the mouthpiece and breathe in deep and fast. You may hear or feel the capsule vibrate.
- 10. Hold your breath for 10 seconds, or as long as possible. Remove the inhaler from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- 11. Take another breath in through mouth piece to ensure you receive the complete dose.
- 12. Repeat steps 8-11.
- 13. Open capsule chamber of the inhaler and dispose of used capsule.

 Do not touch capsule once it's been pierced!




Respimat® Inhaler

Medication currently available in Respimat®: Spiriva®, Combivent®, Striverdi®, Stiolto®

Putting together and priming your inhaler:

Your Respimat® inhaler comes in two parts: a cartridge of medication and an inhaler.



- 2. Put the clear base back onto the inhaler, then turn base in direction of the arrows until you hear a click.
- Press dose release button. Close the cap and repeat three more times if needed until a cloud is seen. Date your inhaler to expire three months after the primed date.

Using your Respimat® inhaler:

- 1. Keep cap closed. Turn base in direction of the arrows until you hear a click. Open cap. Your inhaler is now ready.
- 2. Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- 3. Take in a slow, deep breath and press the button. Keep breathing in slowly.
- 4. Hold your breath for 10 seconds, or as long as possible.
- 5. Remove inhaler from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth. Close the cap.
- 6. If more than one dose is prescribed, repeat steps 1-5. *Turn-Open-Press*.

Metered Dose Inhaler

Medications currently available in MDI: Ventolin® HFA, ProAir® HFA, Proventil® HFA, Xopenex® HFA, Advair® HFA, Symbicort®, Dulera®, QVAR® HFA, Flovent®, Asmanex® HFA, Atrovent® HFA, Alvasco®

- 1. A spacer should ALWAYS be used when using an MDI.
- 2. Remove cap and shake inhaler for five seconds.
- 3. Place your inhaler in the back of the spacer.
- 4. Breathe out through your mouth.
- 5. Place the mouth piece of the spacer between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouth piece.
- 6. Push the top of the canister down and breathe in slowly and deeply through your mouth. Spacer should not whistle!
- 7. Hold your breath for 10 seconds or as long as comfortable.
- 8. Remove spacer from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- If more than one dose is prescribed, wait at least 60 seconds and repeat steps 2-8.

Diskus® (Accuhaler)

Medication currently available in a Diskus®: Serevent®, Advair®, Flovent®


- 1. Hold the Diskus® in your left hand while pushing the thumb grip away with your right thumb, now the inhaler is ready.
- 2. Slide the lever away from you until you hear a click. Do not shake the Diskus®!
- 3. While holding the Diskus® level, turn your head away from the inhaler, and blow out completely. **Do not breathe into the Diskus®!**
- 4. Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- 5. Breathe in very fast and steady.
- 6. Hold your breath for 10 seconds, or as long as possible.
- 7. Remove the Diskus® from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- 8. Close the Diskus® by sliding thumb grip back towards you as far as it will go.
- 9. If more than one dose is prescribed, repeat steps 1-7.
- 10. Rinse your mouth. Do not swallow!

Pressair®

Medication currently available in Pressair®: Tudorza®

- 1. Remove the protective green cap by squeezing the arrows on the device.
- 2. Press and release the green button.
- 3. Check the control window to make sure your dose is ready, it should be green. If not, push the green button on the device again.
- 4. Turn your head away from the inhaler and blow out completely.

 Do not breathe into inhaler!
- 5. Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- 6. Breathe in quickly and deeply until you hear a click. Continue to inhale after you hear the click to receive the full dose.
- 7. Hold your breath for 10 seconds, or as long as possible. Remove inhaler from mouth.
- 8. Breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- 9. If the window is still green, replace steps 4-8.
- 10. Replace the green cap.

Flexhaler®

Medications currently available in Flexhaler®: Pulmicort ™

- 1. Hold the inhaler upright and twist the cap counter-clockwise to remove it.
- 2. Holding the inhaler in the middle, twist the brown grip on the bottom in one direction until it stops. Then, turn it back until it clicks.
- 3. Turn your head away from the inhaler and blow out completely.

 Do not breathe into the inhaler! Do not shake the inhaler!
- 4. Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- 5. Breathe in deeply and forcefully.
- 6. Hold your breath for 10 seconds or as long as possible.
- 7. Remove the inhaler from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- 8. If more than one dose is prescribed, wait at least one minute and repeat steps 2-7. Then, rinse your mouth. **Do not swallow!**



Twist Click

Important Information:

Respiclick®

Medication currently available in Respiclick®: ProAir™

- Make sure the cap is completely closed before each dose. Do not shake!
- Hold the inhaler upright as you open the cap. You will hear a click when it is open all the way. Your inhaler is now ready.
- Turn your head away from the inhaler and blowout completely. Do not breathe into the inhaler!
- Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- Breathe in deeply.
- Hold your breath for 10 seconds or as long as possible.
- Remove inhaler from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- 8. Always close the cap after each use so your inhaler will be ready for your next treatment.
- If more than one dose is prescribed, repeat steps 2-8.

Twisthaler®

Medication currently available in the Twisthaler®: Asmanex®

- Hold the inhaler upright and twist the white cap counterclockwise and lift it off. Do not shake!
- Turn your head away from the inhaler and blow out completely. Do not breathe into the inhaler!
- Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- Breathe in rapidly and deeply.
- Hold your breath for 10 seconds, or as long as possible.
- Remove inhaler from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- Replace cap and turn clockwise until it clicks.
- If more than one dose is prescribed, repeat steps 1-7.
- Rinse your mouth. Do not swallow!

Aerolizer

Medication currently available in Aerolizer: Foradil®

- Remove the outer cap.
- Hold inhaler at the base and turn mouthpiece in direction of the arrow on the device.
- Take one blister from the card. Peel away the paper backing from one. Then push the capsule through the foil.
- Place the capsule into the compartment of the base of the inhaler. Do not shake!
- Twist the mouthpiece to close.
- Hold the inhaler with the buttons facing left and right, not up and down. Only press one time!
- Turn your head away from the inhaler and blow out completely. Do not breathe into the inhaler!
- Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- Inhale quickly and deeply. You may hear the capsule vibrate.
- Hold your breath for 10 seconds or as long as possible, then breathe out slowly.
- Remove the inhaler from your mouth and breathe out slowly through your mouth.
- Remove empty capsule from the base and throw away.
- Replace the outer cap when finished.

Neohaler™

Medication currently available in Neohaler™: Arcapta™

- Remove top cover cap.
- Tilt the mouthpiece back to open the capsule chamber.
- Take one blister and peel away the backing to expose the foil. With dry hands, remove the capsule from the blister.
- Place the capsule into the capsule chamber. Close the inhaler mouthpiece. You should hear a click.
- Hold the inhaler upright. Push both buttons on each end of inhaler until you hear a *click*, then release.
- Turn your head away from the inhaler and blow out completely. Do not breathe into the inhaler!
- Place the mouthpiece between your teeth and seal your lips around the mouthpiece.
- Hold the inhaler with the buttons facing the left and right (not up and down).
- Breathe in rapidly and steadily, as deeply as you can.
- Hold your breath for 10 seconds or as long as possible.
- Remove inhaler from your mouth and breath out slowly through your mouth.
- Discard capsule from base of the inhaler, if not empty, and repeat steps 6-11.
