

Volunteers by the Numbers – 2019

- **1,335** different individuals volunteered during 2019
 - **457** (34%) were **High School students** (students 14 – 18)
 - **88** were **College students** (7%)
 - **790** were **Adults** (59%)
 - Volunteers range from **23 14-year olds** to **9** who are **90+** years of age
- **118,213 hours** of service were recorded in 2018 (increase of 5%)
 - Equals **54** additional FTEs
 - Contribution valued at **\$2.38 million** (Source: independent sector; KY value)
- **426** volunteers were **new** to the team
 - Includes **110** adults, **56** College students, and **260** HS students
- **138** individuals volunteered **more than 200 hours** (an average of 4 to 20 hours per week the entire year)
 - **5 adults** volunteered **over 700 hours** in 2019; each greater than a 0.3 FTE
- **21** individuals have been volunteering for **25 or more years**
 - **1** for greater than **47 years**
- Through the skills and talents of volunteers; capacity was increased in
 - **26 Nursing Units**
 - **5 Emergency Departments**
 - **48 System Departments**
 - **13** new volunteer positions were created with departments
- Growing **Paws for Patients** added **6 new teams**; collectively brought joy to patients, guests and associates with nearly **4000 encounters**
- The Florence and Ft. Thomas Auxiliaries and the Covington Second Time Around Thrift Shop funded **ten \$1000 Scholarships** awarded to selected graduating **High School volunteers**
- **Adult volunteers** indicating that **St. Elizabeth is the BEST PLACE** for them **TO VOLUNTEER** increased from **92.7%** to **95%**
