Emergency medical technicians (EMTs) and paramedics care for the sick or injured in emergency medical settings. People's lives often depend on the quick reaction and competent care provided by these pre-hospital professionals. EMTs and paramedics respond to emergency calls, performing medical services, and transporting patients to medical facilities.

At the completion of this five-month course, you will be credentialed by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) as a National Registry EMT-B. Guidelines

- Holds a valid driver's license.
- Must be of good moral character.
- Holds a high school diploma or GED by the date of the National Registry Exam.
- Understands, reads, speaks, and writes the English language with a comprehension and performance level equal to at least the 9th to 12th grade level.
- Has not been convicted of a felony.
- Submit a signed application for Emergency Medical Technician Basic Certification.
- Covered by Workers Compensation or has insurance to cover any injury that occurs during class or clinical time.
- Has been vaccinated for Hepatitis B or is in the process.
- Must have completed TB skin test with documented results from the current year.

Cancellation/Rescheduling/Substitutions

Applicants must cancel prior to one week before the start of class or their fee is forfeited.

Course fees include books, pocket mask and CPR certification. Price does not include final testing or National Registry written testing.
